



Hot Weather Policy

As an affiliated member of Golf Australia, the Mount Gambier Golf Club has chosen to run competitions in line with the Hot Weather Guidelines as adopted by Golf Australia. Whilst in most cases scheduled competitions will be held, they will be rescheduled to an appropriate time in the event of an extreme weather event.

The Mount Gambier Golf Club (MGGC) Management Committee expects that all players carefully consider the conditions, as well as their own personal health and circumstances, before choosing to play in one of the golf club's events. Members are also to take appropriate precautions and actions both before, during and after their game to ensure their own personal safety.

MGGC Events:

(NOTE: This hot weather policy applies only to events that are conducted by the MGGC. External organisations conducting events will operate under their own policy).

Policy Trigger Point: When the BOM's forecast for WORROLONG for the event date, as at 12:00 midday on the day prior to the event, is 38° or above the following applies.

“The course is closed from 9:00am for the commencement of all 18 hole competition events.

- **Players who choose to play prior to or after this time do so at their own risk.**
- **No competition entries will be accepted after this time.”**

- Morning tee times only
- Tee times 7:00am – 9:00am only
- Hit off on the 1st and 10th tees only
- If the scheduled event is stroke, it will revert to stableford to assist with pace of play and the stroke event will be rescheduled to the following week.
